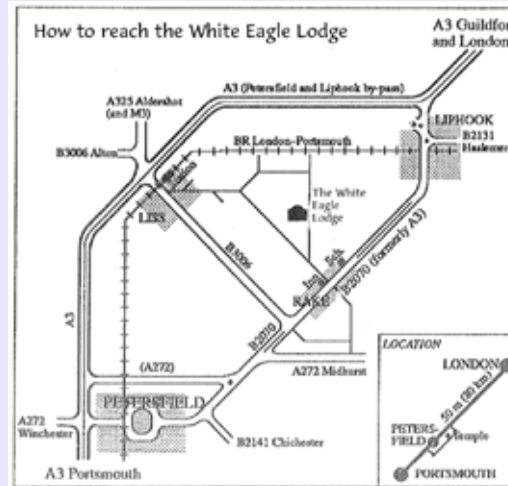

Family Days

Family Days are open to all, not just those with children.

White Eagle Family Days at New Lands are held in the Temple on the first Sunday of most months from 10.30am – 3.00pm.

You are welcome to come along for all or any part of the day, which follows this basic plan:

10.45am Time to meet (in the meeting room) plus refreshments, craft table, outside play facilities and grounds.

11.30am Family service in the temple (usually includes a story, singing, movement and visualisation, and lasts about 50mins).

12.30pm Bring and share vegetarian lunch (in the meeting room).

1.30pm - 2.30pm (end) optional activity or social time (eg craft, yoga, healing service..)
